**RESOLUTION APPROVING PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGN
WITH PEDESTRIAN WARNING AT THE NORTH EXIT OF THE
EARLHAM COMMUNITY BUILDING PARKING LOT**

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2015, the Earlham City Council approved Ordinance No. 375, Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Earlham, Iowa, 2007, Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices, granting the Council the power to designate and indicate by resolution intersections at which traffic shall be control by traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, the north exit of the Earlham Community Building parking lot has a blind corner to the west; and

WHEREAS, drivers have complained of pedestrians stepping in front of cars exiting the parking lot at this place.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Earlham that a stop sign with a pedestrian warning be placed at the north exit of the Earlham Community Building Center parking Lot.
