

ORDINANCE NO. 417

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EARLHAM, IOWA, 2017, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 106 COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE, SECTION 106.08 COLLECTION FEES

Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Earlham, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION AMENDED. Section 106.08 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Earlham, Iowa, 2017, pertaining to collection fees for the collection and disposal of solid waste in the City, is hereby amended by deleting Subsection 1 and replacing it with the following:

1. Schedule of Fees. The fees for solid waste collection and disposal service, used or available, are:
 - A. For each residential premises and for each dwelling unit of a multiple-family dwelling - \$16.58, plus 3% administrative fee pursuant to subsection 2 of this section) per month, which shall include a 65-gallon recycling toter. The rate will automatically increase on an annual basis by the same percentage increase as the rate paid by the City to the contractor providing the solid waste collection to the City. A monthly billing for environmental and fuel surcharges, as assessed by the contractor, shall be added to these fees for the collection of residential customers. At this rate, in addition to collecting recyclable waste, the City will furnish one toter up to 96 gallons for the collection of said solid waste. Additional toters will be furnished at a cost of \$18.00 each per month to individual residential premises. The City may furnish identifying tags for these additional toters if necessary.
 - B. For commercial, industrial and institutional premises the monthly fees are:

4 yard dumpster	\$80.73	\$41.66

8 yard dumpster	\$129.37	\$88.39

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect January 1, 2020.
