

2020 Freedom Fest Request to the City of Earlham

Street dance, Friday July 3rd:

We need to be attached to West Side's building for the serving of alcohol. The dance will run from 8 P.M. To Midnight.

We would like to close Chestnut Ave. for set up at 5:00 P.M. and it remain closed until tear down is done at approximately 1:00 A.M. This would be blocked for the West Side across Chestnut Ave. to the east sidewalk curb. Allowing walking access on east sidewalk of Chestnut Ave.

We would like to use snow fence, posts, and barrels this is from the City as barricades.

Parade route, Saturday July 4th:

We would like to have the same parade route as last year, ending at the corner of N.E. Plum and N.E. 6th St.

Starting at the School entrance, go east on N. W. 4th until Chestnut, go south on Chestnut Ave. go south on Chestnut Ave. to 1st St., turn east on 1st St. and go to Maple Ave., turn North on Maple Ave., and go to N.E. 4th St., turn east on 4th St. and go to N.E. Plum Ave., turn north on N.E. Plum Ave., and continue to N.E. 6th St. Parade entries could then turn left and go back to the school. This route allows Pioneer Place to easily view the parade, as well as it extends our parade length. Which helps with congestion at the school parking lot.

We would like to ask that the Earlham Police Department put up no parking signs along the parade route the night before, as they have in the past.

Park activities, Saturday July 4th:

We would like the following street to be blocked:

Sycamore between 1st St. and 3rd St. People can walk freely back and forth to church, car show and the park.

Also, N.E. 2nd, N.E. 3rd and Maple.

5 K Run: I believe that the 5 K will run the same a year's in the past.

Additional park requests:

Key to the bathrooms to restock toilet paper and paper towels and tending to trash cans. We would like an additional trash dumpster at the park. As well as snow fence installed (or snow fence, posts, and post hole digger left for us) blocking off the horseshoe area.

We would again like to use two golf carts for transportation needs during the events. We will ensure that each driver is licensed and the cart is properly identified as being used for Freedom Fest.

New this year:

We would like to have a Beer Garden set up at the park during the days activities of the Friday July, 4th 2020. We are proposing that this be set up at the south east corner of the park. We would like this event to open after the finish of the Parade Noon – the last event in park depending on interest of crowd.

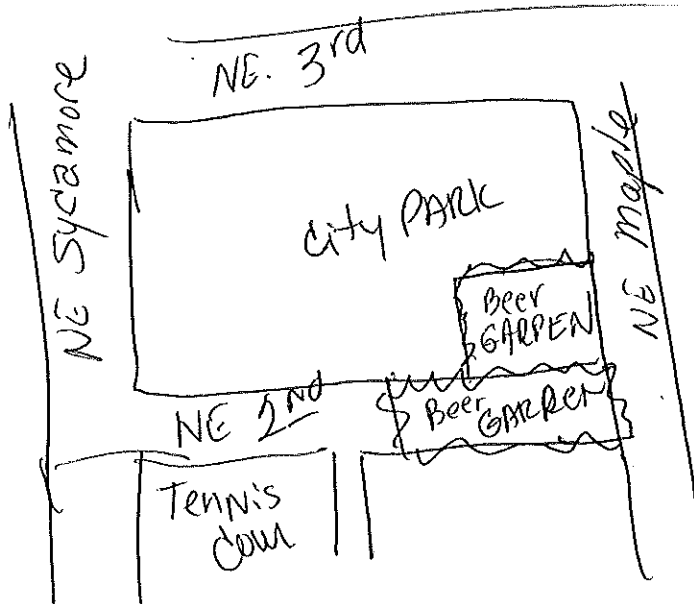

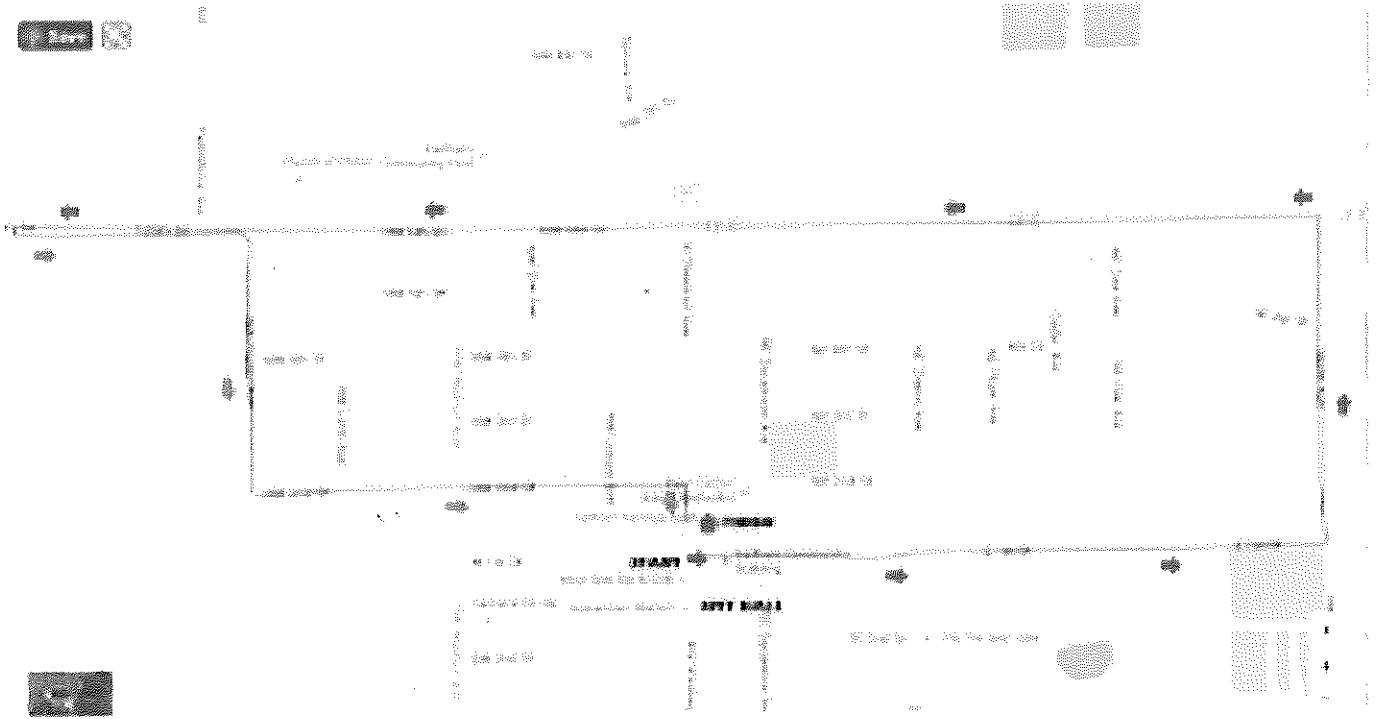

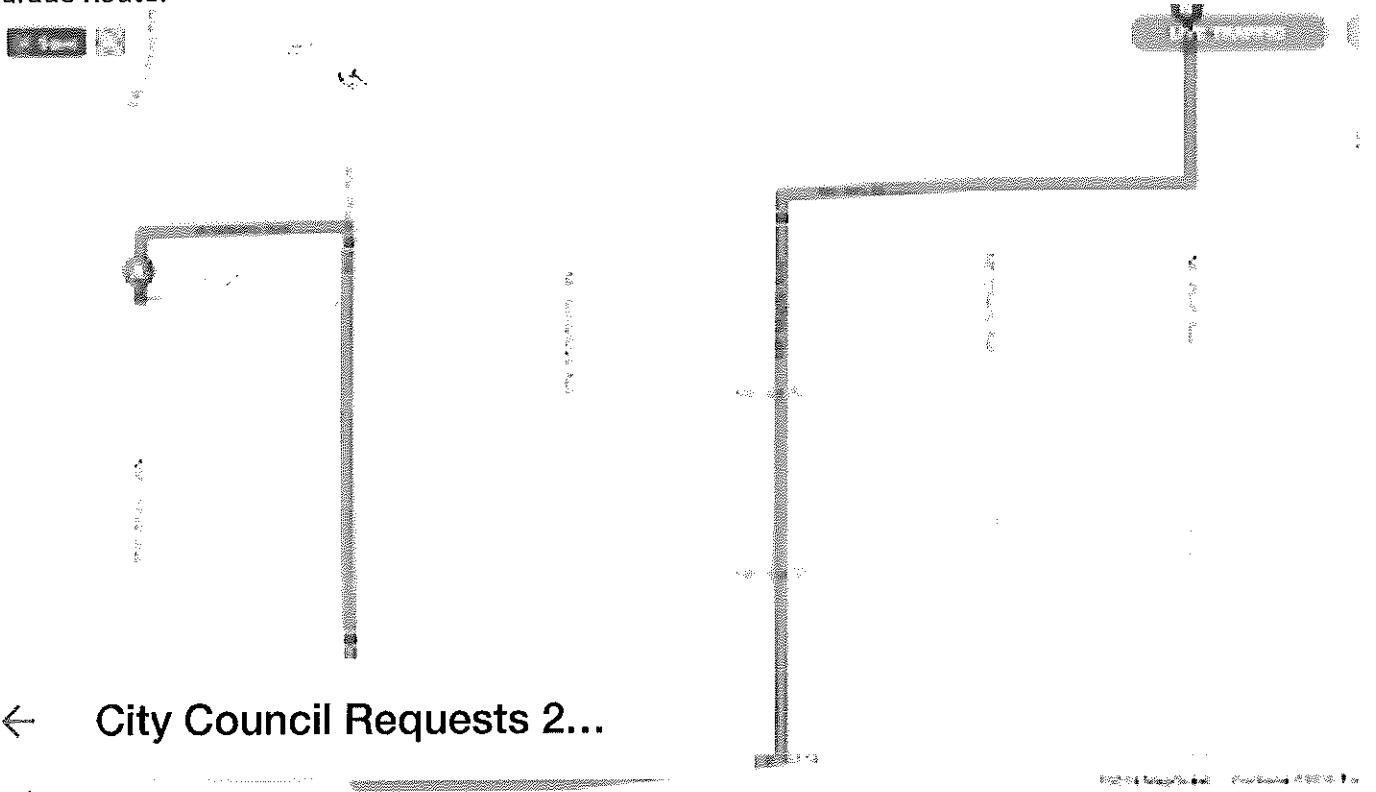
