Ordinance 15.03 and lowa Code 372.4 speak to what officials the mayor appoints, and this new committee doesn't fall under those sections. In fact, 372.4(2) states "Other officers must be selected as directed by the council." In my opinion, it would take an ordinance to establish this committee, and in that ordinance the council could give the mayor the authority to appoint the members with or without council approval.
