

ORDINANCE NO. 428

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EARLHAM, IOWA, CHAPTER 55.05 LIVESTOCK

Be it Enacted by the City Council of the City of Earlham, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 55.05 of Code of Ordinances of the City of Earlham, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

55.05 LIVESTOCK. It is unlawful for a person to keep livestock within the City except by written consent of the Council or except in compliance with the City's zoning regulations and Chapter 58 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
