**RESOLUTION APPROVING PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS,
BOTH NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND,
ON NW LOCUST AVENUE AT THE INTERSTION WITH NW 3RD STREET**

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2015, the Earlham City Council approved Ordinance No. 375, Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Earlham, Iowa, 2007, Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices, granting the Council the power to designate and indicate by resolution intersections at which traffic shall be control by traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned intersection is commonly used by school children before and after school; and,

WHEREAS, close encounters between motorist and pedestrians (school children) have been observed at this intersection;

WHEREAS, the Earlham Community School District's Safety Committee has requested stop signs be placed on NW Locust Street at the intersection with NW 3rd Street, both northbound and southbound.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Earlham, that stop signs, both northbound and southbound, shall be placed on NW Locust Avenue at the intersection with NW 3rd Street.
