**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO 22-38, CHANGING
PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS FROM NORTHBOUND/SOUTHBOUND TO
EASTBOUND/WESTBOUND AT THE INTERSTION OF
NW LOCUST AVENUE AND NW 3RD STREET**

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2015, the Earlham City Council approved Ordinance No. 375, Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Earlham, Iowa, 2007, Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices, granting the Council the power to designate and indicate by resolution intersections at which traffic shall be control by traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2022, the Earlham City Council passed Resolution No 22-38, approving the placement of stop signs northbound and southbound at the intersection of NW Locust and NW 3rd Street; and

WHEREAS, the Earlham Public Works department along with the Earlham Community School District decided the stop signs should instead be placed eastbound and westbound.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Earlham, that the stop signs at the intersection of NW Locust Avenue and NW 3rd Street shall be placed Eastbound and Westbound.
