

2022 Earlham Rescue Report

In 2022, Earlham Rescue responded to 204 requests for service, down 9 from last year. The total member responses to these calls was 743 for an average of 3.6 providers per response, which is the same average as last year. 87% of the calls had at least 1 advanced level provider responding and the other 13% had EMT level providers. Our average response time is 6.11 minutes from page to en route, goal is under 5 daytime and 6 nighttime, and our average time from page to on scene is 9.73 minutes, which is in line with the national goal of 8-10 minutes. We started the year with 13 members on the squad and 1 driver. One member resigned this year to focus their time elsewhere. The members meet every second and fourth Thursday of the month for business meetings and training. Rescue members accumulated a total of 195 hours of continuing education, not including Gavin Boyle finishing Paramedic School which is equivalent to approximately 1520 hours.

Our membership included 6 Paramedics, 3 RNs, 4 EMTs and 1 Driver. The RNs and Paramedics can function at an AEMT level. Dr. Jon Suddarth remains our medical director. The medical director establishes protocols, verifies skills, and reviews run documentation. Blake Boyle was reelected as the membership's nomination for Captain. Tabitha Royster and Don Mudge were reelected as the 1st and 2nd Lieutenants respectively.

The members of the Rescue would like to take this opportunity to thank the mayor and council for their continued support of the Earlham Rescue Unit, the community for their support to the Rescue Association, and the Earlham Fire and Police Departments whose assistance allows us to provide quality care to patients in a safe environment. We would like to thank the Madison and Dallas County Sheriff's Offices Dispatchers and Deputies for their work behind the scenes and at incidents with us. Finally, we thank the County Emergency Management and Public Health Departments for their partnership through the pandemic.

I am proud of our members' commitment to maintaining this high level of care for our community on a volunteer service. We look forward to continuing to serve the community. Please contact myself or anyone of the members with question, needs or concerns.
