


Parade Route-Tuesday, July 4th



5k Route-Tuesday, July 4th


The 5k will be the same route as previous years. Can we get the route marked again? We need to have that done prior to the event. Here is the map. 8 am start time.


This is a rough draft park layout. New this year is the Carnival. The red marks are the streets that need to be blocked off so that no one parks around the park or in these designated areas. The carnival will be setting up Sunday evening/Monday morning to allow them to open Monday afternoon. We are asking to have those streets blocked early to facilitate carnival set up. The carnival will go all the way up 2nd st. The carnival will extend slightly north onto Sycamore, but then extend south on Sycamore all the way until 1st street. The streets we are requesting to be blocked would be Sycamore and the corner of NE 3rd, Sycamore and across the sidewalk of NE 2nd, and where Sycamore meets 1st street. The alley east of the tennis courts on 2nd would also need to be blocked as well as the alley directly across the park on the north side of 3rd street. Maple and the corner of 3rd as well as Maple and the corner of 2nd also need to be blocked. 3rd street wouldn't necessarily need to be blocked Sunday evening, but could be if you are wanting to do it all at once, otherwise Monday evening would work, so that people aren't parking around the park for Tuesday's events. The cornhole tournament will be at the park Monday afternoon on that side, but shouldn't be a problem if people access 3rd street that day.



The freedom fest has really grown in size. One of the problems we ran into last year is we did not have enough trash receptacles throughout the park. This year we are requesting 7 dumpsters as well as 10 trash bins to be stationed throughout the park. See pic for reference. We are also looking into added some additional portable bathrooms on either side of the park. Additional dumpsters would be located in alley, along with possibly a few more portable bathrooms in this area.
